Throughout her tertiary level studies, Yuh T'sun has been the recipient of many awards and scholarships. These include winning the first prize in the Eisteddfod Senior piano concerto competition in 2002 and also the Geoffrey Parson's Award in 2005 where she performed with Janis Laurs.

In three consecutive years, she was also awarded scholarships for most outstanding piano student in her year.

During August last year, Yuh T'sun took a trip to Europe where she successfully participated in masterclasses and summer schools with leading international piano teachers.

Yuh T'sun is currently studying Masters in Performance at the Elder Conservatorium.

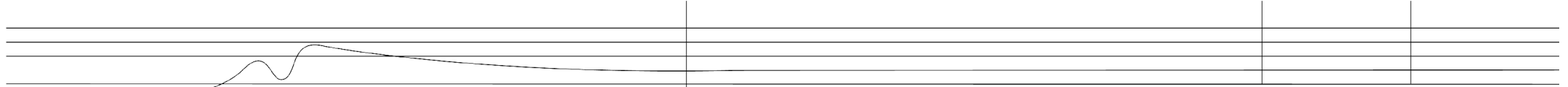
