He was selected as an RCM Rising Star and was later on staff as a Junior Fellow in Piano Accompaniment. In the UK, he won several competitions, including the Keyboard Prize and the Accompanist Prize in the Royal Over-Seas League Competition, and regularly performed throughout London and the UK. Since moving back to Australia, Michael has established himself as one of the most sought-after associate artists for national and international guests. He is currently a staff pianist at the Elder Conservatorium. Alongside his 'classical' duties, Michael is also the keyboard player for the Tributes in Concert Band, consistently praised as one of the best in the business after making their US debut in 2019.
