Mark Smith began learning the trumpet in primary school after he discovered he had a natural aptitude for the instrument. Unable to access lessons at his school, he rode his bike to the local high school each week to have his lessons there. After finishing his high school studies, Mark went on to complete a Bachelor of Music degree with Honours in Trumpet and Composition and, later, a Master of Music degree in Composition at the Elder School of Music.

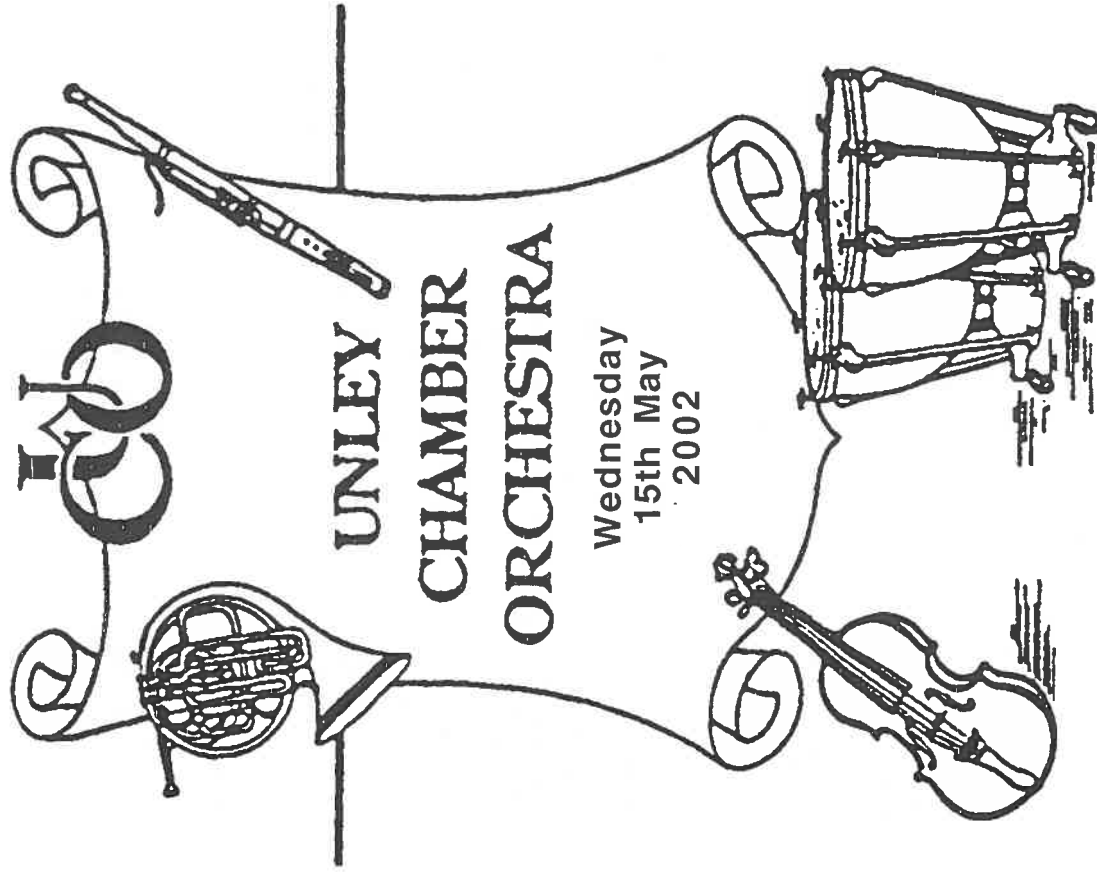
Mark is currently teaching Instrumental Music in a number of schools and runs his own music publishing company - Mark Smith Music Services. He also holds the position of Principal Cornet with the Kensington and Norwood Brass Band and has been playing lead Trumpet and arranging Christmas carols and guest artist orchestrations for the annual Carols by Candlelight in recent years.

Looking for a personal challenge, Mark entered the Wind, Brass and Percussion Concerto section of the Adelaide Eisteddfod last year. He was one of four finalists chosen to compete in the finals and, while he did not win the section, he was awarded the Unley Chamber Orchestra Prize - a medallion, \$100 and the opportunity to perform a concerto with the Unley Chamber Orchestra. Tonight he performs the popular and well known Haydn Trumpet Concerto - the first concerto written for a Trumpet that was able to play chromatically.

The Unley Chamber Orchestra Medallion will be presented to Mark tonight by the President of the Adelaide Eisteddfod Society, Mr Malcolm Potter.
